The Programme

IBM and IIMM have decided to jointly organize education programmes of mutual interest. Both the organisations recognize the importance of imparting quality education in supply chain management that is undergoing a constant evolution. According to the need of the day, both the organizations agree to introduce an advanced Diploma programme in supply chain management to build a multi-disciplinary knowledge bank for a young team of professionals who could adopt a managerial approach to resolve the supply dynamics both at the micro and the macro level.

A Unique Learning Platform

Advanced Diploma in Supply Chain Management has been specially designed for the participants who wish to pursue their career in Supply Chain Management. Supply chain management professionals face enormous challenges to establish strategic sourcing, optimize inventory level or to manage the global logistical issues in view of the ever-changing geo-political scenario. The supply chain managers have their task cut out today to maintain the customer service level by constantly rebalancing supply with demand. With this end in view, the participants will be taught the concept of integrated materials management, interrelationship among the various departments, flow of information and documents to make a seamless journey from planning & provisioning to sourcing, storing and operations. The sessions on logistics will help students identify modern warehousing with extensive use of automation, economizing transportation cost through consolidation and outsourcing. Adequate exposure to statistical tools, information technology, ERP, use of artificial intelligence and robotics at the work place will help enhance the skill set of the supply chain management professionals to showcase their learning in a structured and systematic manner.

Who is this Programme for

Working personnel in the field of supply chain management who do not have structured professional exposure may avail themselves this opportunity to update their domain knowledge. The freshers, who aspire to build their career in techno-commercial jobs related to sourcing & procurement, stores & inventory management, warehousing and logistics may also participate.

Duration

The duration of the programme will be for 52 weeks spread over two semesters. There will be eight modules, four in each of the semesters.

Eligibility

Graduate in any discipline with one-year work experience in a relevant field or Diploma in Engineering with 2 years' work experience. Students pursuing professional undergraduate / post-graduate course in management and engineering in IBM and Jadavpur University, shall be eligible for admission without any work experience. Selection will be based on personality test.

Classes

Classes shall be held twice a week in the evening from 6:30 p.m. to 9:00 p.m.

Academic Team

The experienced faculty from IBM and IIMM will share their knowledge with the participants. IBM is a reputed academic institution with highly experienced in-house faculty drawn from both academia and industry. IIMM, the pioneering institute in the country to promote supply chain learning in the country has developed and nurtured a team of versatile and professionally competent faculty with industry connect. Students shall have the unique benefit to blend the theoretical learning process with what is followed in practice.

Library Facility

IBM has well-stacked library with more than 12,000 books. The institute subscribes to various National and International journals. There is an airconditioned reading room adjoining the library with an in-house photocopy facility for the students. Library database has been developed through "KOHA" the full-featured open-source integrated library software. IIMM has also a library at 8B, Short Street, Kolkata- 700 017 to lend latest reference books on Supply Chain Management to its students.

Computer & Communication Laboratory

IBM is equipped with the state-of-the art computer facilities with two computer laboratories comprising more than 80 nodes in LAN, high speed internet & WI-FI. The Communication Laboratory of IBM is equipped with the most modern gadgets for enhancing communication and personality development of the students with emphasis on team building. Computer Laboratory is supported with modern statistical & data analysis tools like SPSS, Ms Excel, Ms Project, Ace Equity, Statcraft & R.

Evalution System

Assessment will be done through written examination to be held in the IBM campus at the end of each semester. Special emphasis will be given to the development of soft skill. Due weightage will be given to internal assessment which will be done by the faculty based on attendance, participation in classroom discussion, group discussion/group task, public speaking and performance in viva voce. Students will be taken to visit warehouse/workshop to make their learning process meaningful.

Placement Cell

IIMM and IBM have full-fledged placement assistance cell. Reasonable assistance is extended to deserving candidates based on vacancies in various industries. Course Fee
